## 2002 Season By-Laws

#### Members

Membership is limited to a total of 30 golfers who play regularly and pay the dues. The dues for 2002 will be \$20 per member. This must be paid to Jerry Steinhilber by the First Jamborie

#### Playing Priority

To be included in the day's events, players should arrive at least 15 minutes before scheduled play which will be 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday for the entire season. A player may check in by phone if he will be late

Priority for team plan will always go first to paying member unless a member checks in after the teams have been made out. In that case, the late member will be treated as a non-paying member for that day. This will be based on a first-come, first play basis.

#### Golf Rules

The official rules of golfing will apply except that "winter rules" are in effect.

### Handicaps

Teams will be selected using the handicaps provided by Larry Streeter.

#### Rules for Paying for Events

The Nassau Golf System will be used. Each player in the foursome puts \$3 in the pot (\$4 in threesomes). Fivesomes should be avoided, if possible. The point system will be used with a winner on front, back nine, and total. In case of a tie, the money is split. One team can win entire amount. Points are calculated as follows:

5 points
5 points
4 points
3 points
2 points
1 point

#### Other Prizes

The following other prizes are awarded during each event and the money is collected separately:

Chip In's & Sandies -25 cents each
Eagles -50 cents each
Hole in One and
Double Eagle - \$1 (plus \$25 and name added to plaque (paid by club).

There will be three special functions during the 2002 season. These events will include two Jambories and a Club Championship tourney with steak fry following each event at the KB Club on Adams Street. See calendar on reverse for dates. Tee Times for Jambories and Club Championship will be posted with a sign-up sheet for each event. To be eligible, \$20 dues must be paid by June 10, 2002
